

- If you are a multisport athlete that then you must schedule TEAM SPORTS S1 and TEAM SPORTS S2
 - Example would be football in fall and baseball in spring.

Students and parents should consider graduation requirements, college entrance requirements and TOPS requirements when selecting courses the student will take each year of high school. To enter online course requests, click on the yellow pencil and the courses offered for that subject area will appear. More than one course can be selected in that subject area if needed. The printed copy must be signed/dated by both the student and the parent or legal guardian. This signed copy will also serve as written confirmation of receipt of both the current diploma and TOPS requirements.
