Cost: \$400 (All required fees must be paid in order to purchase Driver's Ed! We suggest logging in to SCO and verifying that you have <u>NO</u> outstanding required fees.) The price includes the classroom and behind the wheel drive times. Students will receive a ½ credit towards graduation upon successful completion of the course.

<u>Students must be 15 years old by June 15, 2024</u> & be enrolled in a Livingston Parish Public School to be eligible for Driver's Education.

Classroom Dates: Mon. April 15 - Fri. April 19 (3:30pm - 8:00pm) <u>AND</u> Saturday, April 20 (8am - 3:30pm) ***YOU MUST ATTEND EVERY DAY***

Class will be held at the DS Freshman High Cafeteria. Meet in the DSFH Commons Area near the cafeteria before class on the first day of class. (April 15th). This session is limited to 80 students.

Driving times will be assigned during the classroom session. <u>All driving will be completed in May and/or over the summer break.</u> We will try to accommodate the student's needs, but remember there is limited seating in a car and all students cannot drive at the same time. Be sure your summer schedule accommodates Driver's Ed. Please remember classroom hours are mandated by State law and cannot be missed. <u>THE STUDENT MUST BE 15 YEARS OLD IN ORDER TO DRIVE THE VEHICLE</u>.
