\$75.00 per additional ½ credit (If a student completes a course early he/she can take an additional course for an additional fee of \$75. The second class must be paid in full prior to starting AND approved by the school site principal. All work must be complete by the last day of virtual school.)

Eligibility:

All Livingston Parish public school students in grades 9-12 with principal's permission are eligible.

A student may only register for 1 course for ½ credit per site.

Must have a minimum of 14 students registered to make a session at a school.

Transportation: Students must provide their own transportation.

Tuition: \$175.00 (Includes a \$25.00 non-refundable application fee.)

If a student completes a course early he/she can take an additional course for an additional fee of \$75.

Initial fee of \$175.00 must be paid in advance at registration with credit/debit card, cash, cashier's check, or money orders. NO personal checks accepted.

Refunds:

There will be **no refunds** to students who drop out of the program or to students who are expelled. **Once class starts on January 18th , there will be no refunds available.**

Virtual School Rules and Regulations:

1. Attendance in each class is critical. **A maximum of 3 absences will be allowed.** This includes illness or doctor excuses. Once you complete the class satisfactorily, you do not have to return to class.
2. Students are expected to conform to the same rules of conduct and dress code that are in effect during the regular school session. This includes **no cell phone usage in class.**
3. Credit Recovery is an additional effort on the part of the school district to provide students the opportunity to make up deficiencies in required courses or receive credit in new courses. The rights of all students to avail themselves of this opportunity, free of disruption and/or distraction, will be insured through a school setting conducive to learning. Students who fail to conform in an appropriate manner will be immediately expelled from Virtual School and will lose credit and fees. Virtual School grades, passing or otherwise, will become a permanent part of the student's school records/transcript.
